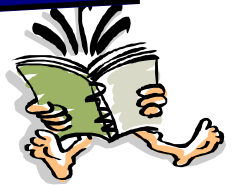

Class Descriptions...

Basic Stamping: \$10

Do you have a little fear of stamping on your scrapbook pages? Well, have no fear because in this class you will do all the messing up with none of the cleaning up! We will make some background paper using stamps, a shrink plastic ribbon charm, and we will even stamp some ribbon! Bring several photos so you can go home with two finished layouts! Kathy.

Class Supplies. For all our classes, you need to bring a basic toolkit including: a 12" Trimmer, a scissors, your favorite double sided adhesive, liquid glue, pop dots, a pencil, bone folder, scoring tool, and a ruler. For many classes you may need other specific tools for that class (which we will tell you about.) Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.
