A great tip!

I love those "labels" like you can make on the plastic strips with the little tool you can get at an office supply store... but the main problem (for me) is that the strips of plastic are not acid free. Also is the issue of color matching... I like all the colors on my page to MATCH and sometimes the strips of plastic available are just not the right color!

So ONE solution:

Do the labels on your computer!

Go on the web and download the font "plastique."

(I found it on www.fontpoint.com)

In a word processing document:

- make a text box
- fill color to your choice
- add text using the plastique font
- change the font to white
- print out and trim the words into strips
- adhere to card or page and they look just like those labels!
- *(if you swipe them with a little Mod Podge, they really look like plastic!)*

Class Descriptions...

Artist Trading Cards: \$12

We have discovered that designing a 2 1/2 x 3 1/2 piece of artwork can be more daunting for some people than making a standard card. Learn about Artist Trading Cards and just what you can do with them besides trading with friends. We will make several quick and classy trading cards and design a greeting card using your favorite ATC as the main element. You will learn to love them and look forward to tucking them in your kid's lunch, your husband's brief case or your best friend's birthday greeting. Myra.

Basic Stamping: \$10
