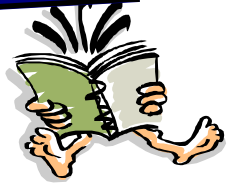

A great tip!

I understand that many people who read last month's tip (thanks for the positive feedback) didn't know how to download a font. So here's how:

On a font site (my two favorites are fontfreak.com & fontgarden.com) you click the font shortcut that you want in order to download it and save it to your desktop.

Usually you will download a compressed file, which you need to unzip. Most of you will have this utility on your computer, so you just "right click", choose extract all (or something similar).

Once the file is extracted you just copy the new font file into the font folder. To do this, right click on the True Type file, choose "copy." Open the control panel (under "my computer" either on your desktop or the start menu), then open the Fonts folder. Once in the font folder, right click and choose "paste".

It really **is** easy. Enjoy all your new font choices out there!

Class Descriptions...

Artist Trading Cards: \$12

We have discovered that designing a 2 1/2 x 3 1/2 piece of artwork can be more daunting for some people than making a standard card. Learn about Artist Trading Cards and just what you can do with them besides trading with friends. We will make several quick and classy trading cards and design a greeting card using your favorite ATC as the main element. You will learn to love them and look forward to tucking them in your kid's lunch, your husband's brief case or your best friend's birthday greeting. Myra.

Basic Stamping: \$10

Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.
