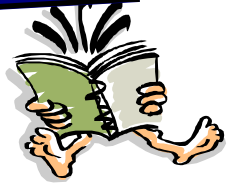

Class Descriptions...

Basic Stamping: \$10

Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.
