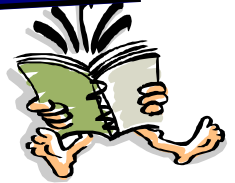

Timely Tip!

This month's tip comes from Myra... and it really does work, I have tried it too!

Ever had a rub on "accident"? You know, where you accidentally get your rub on in the wrong place, or you tried to rub ONE from a sheet (rather than cut out the one you wanted) and had too much transfer... or had a little "user error" and your rub on shifted on you a little, and you don't like the result?

Well, if you have an adhesive pick up "eraser" (if you don't, you can come here to get one...) you can take that rub on right off! (An adhesive pick-up is a square of rubber used to pick up extra adhesive on your projects.)

Of course, your rubbed off rub on cannot be used again, but at least you can start over and haven't wrecked your project.

On a related note: for anyone in LOVE with UNDU Adhesive remover—they have removed it from the market! Some chemical in it was found to be dangerous and they have pulled it. We hope they reformulate it and get it back out on the market, I will keep you informed!

Card of the month allows you to make 12 cards (3 each of 4 designs) in literally minutes. Most of the pieces are precut and all you need to do is assemble. What other way to get a dozen cards done so fast! If you decide to add more of your own design, they make a great "base"!!

Only \$10.95 with a 12 month membership, \$11.95 with a 6 month membership or \$12.95 one at a time!

Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**
