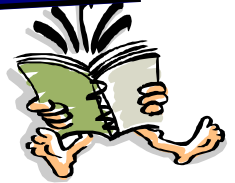

Book Club: \$Free

Card Class with Katrina: \$12

May 27 - Using Vellum to it's best advantage. Come to find out what you've been missing... I promise it's NOT that scary! Katrina.

Card Group: \$Free

We meet, we make cards to exchange, someone in the group teaches us a technique or card idea, we giggle and laugh — it's fun!! We now have TWO groups, one afternoon and one evening. Call if you are interested! We are always looking for new blood... uh...ideas.

Cricut Support Group: \$FREE (with Cricut purchase from here) or \$10

Got your Cricut...cutting away? Having a heck of a good time? Want to be one of the best cutters in the area... let's all learn together!! You won't believe what we've figured out on the Cricut already!! We love this machine!!

Crop 'til you Drop: \$15

Spend your Saturday with one of your most loved pastimes: eating! I mean, scrapping! 12 hours to catch up on your pages, your card making or maybe your girlfriends! What could be more fun? Lunch, dinner, snacks, prizes and FUN!

Digital Hybrid Pages: \$15

Ruth, our resident digital expert, will show you how to manipulate your photos into the letters that make up your page title. This is just an awesome technique. You will also have the opportunity to learn how to do a photo mat montage.

(Sample pages are posted in the store.) Class includes paper and embellishments to make a page spread. You must have a laptop loaded with Photoshop Elements 4.0, 5.0 or 6.0. Printing of one 8*10 with Scrapper's Haven Epson System is included. Bring your photos and your regular toolkit with you to class. Call or visit the store with any questions. Ruth.

FUNDamentals: \$10

Just the basics, all the basics. Receive a \$10 store credit for anything in the store after class. We will do one page as we talk about everything you need to know to get started making your own scrapbook. (We won't use your pictures, as we are teaching techniques.) Ruth.

Kid's Camp: \$15

This group is open to kids (approx. ages 6-12) interested in Mom's scrapping! Christy will work with this group and teach the kids how to make three cards and one paper craft. The kids will get to work with all the high quality craft tools, papers and adhesives that are also kid friendly. All supplies, tools, and adhesives will be included. Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**

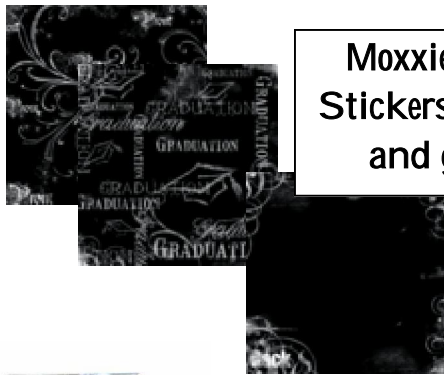
