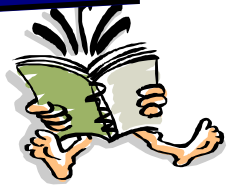

Class Descriptions...

Book Club: \$Free

We have had a great turnout for this group. We have already decided that this is a great, fun way to learn! We use great ideas from Simple Scrapbooks and Paper Crafts! We have a couple of open spots and would love for you to join us!

Card Class with Katrina: \$12

July 22 - Cricut Cards. Are you guilty of letting your Cricut collect dust? Are you using your Cricut for titles on your pages, but that's all? Come to this class and let's make some fun Cricut creations for sending! Could be fun! Katrina.

Scrapping in our workroom is free any time that there is not another event scheduled. We would like nothing better than to have the workroom in use at all times, and we are happy to take "reservations" for groups to come in as well, so...**please, give us a call to make sure we have the space whenever you are ready to scrap.**

Class Supplies. For all our classes, you need to bring a basic toolkit including: a 12" Trimmer, a scissors, your favorite double sided adhesive, glue dots, pop dots, a pencil, bone folder, scoring tool, and a ruler. For many classes you may need other specific tools for that class (which we will tell you about.) Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**

Make up your own class... have at least 4 friends who want to learn about something specific? Or just love one of the classes we have scheduled, but the time is no good? Learn the techniques you have always wanted to learn or get ideas for specific themes. Tell us what you want to do and for how long and we will work with you to design the perfect class for you! (Minimum class size: 4 students)
