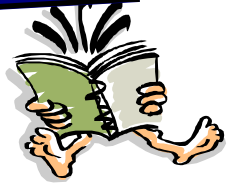

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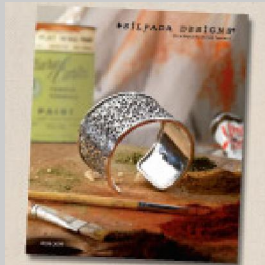
Silpada Open House

Scrap Catch Up...

What do you do when the weather starts getting colder, the days (or at least the daylight part) gets shorter? Bundle up and scrap, of course!

The longer, cooler evenings lend themselves to homey pursuits. Perhaps you like to sew or cook... but let's face it, nothing is more rewarding than getting your precious memories preserved.

I don't know about you, but I have a tendency lately to scrap just the pictures that I feel like doing, which is awesome, but leaves me a little behind in the photos I feel like I "have" to do, or "should" do. One of the most common questions I get asked is HOW I keep up with my own scrapping, so...here's MY process.

Step 1. Photos. I just discovered Shutterfly. I bet many of you already know all about this... but I uploaded and ordered 187 photos to be picked up right at Target! I was very pleased with the results. Certainly, if I need enlargements or scanned photos, I will do them myself on our system, as our system is the best at these tasks, but a normal, digital 4*6 is most cost effective to get done at a photo shop like this.

Step 2. Page Sorting. I will take this large pile of photos and get page spreads "ready." (Some people call this power sorting.) I take the photos I want to include on one spread, pick out the patterned paper, the cardstock, the stickers, rub-ons, embellishments, etc... put

them in a pile. Sometimes if I have a good idea for the layout I will include a sketch (but not always) and I usually try to jot down the dates and relevant who, what, where, when, why for journaling prompts. All this goes into a 12/12 Art Bin. (I like this brand best, because they CLOSE tightly and they have a handle for easy transport.) One by one, I pick out my spreads and fill up my bin. This means that I spend at least one or two "scrap sessions" doing nothing but page organization. (*This can be a little frustrating when everyone else is making pages... but just wait, it's worth it.*)

Step 3. Scrap! Now I am ready to scrap. Since I spent the time to get my pages ready, when I actually sit down to scrap, I can really power through my layouts. When I am organized and use this system, I get two or three times as many pages DONE when I sit down to scrap. The other BIG advantage to this system, is when you come to a Scrappy Friday or join a friend at their home, all you have to BRING is the art bin and your tote of tools! No more hauling everything you own in order to scrap for a few hours!

Come in to get your pages ready, we are here to help! Here's to getting more done in less time — who doesn't love that idea!

Book Club: \$Free

Class Supplies. For all our classes, you need to bring a basic toolkit including: a 12" Trimmer, a scissors, your favorite double sided adhesive, glue dots, pop dots, a pencil, bone folder, scoring tool, and a ruler. For many classes you may need other specific tools for that class (which we will tell you about.) Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**

Make up your own class... have at least 4 friends who want to learn about something specific? Or just love one of the classes we have scheduled, but the time is no good? Learn the techniques you have always wanted to learn or get ideas for specific themes. Tell us what you want to do and for how long and we will work with you to design the perfect class for you! (Minimum class size: 4 students)

Crop 'til you Drop: \$15
