Class Descriptions...

Card Class with Katrina: \$12

Class Supplies. For all our classes, you need to bring a basic toolkit including: a 12" Trimmer, a scissors, your favorite double sided adhesive, glue dots, pop dots, a pencil, bone folder, scoring tool, and a ruler. For many classes you may need other specific tools for that class (which we will tell you about.) Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**

- Low bed trailer or truck to haul the big furniture.

 - Moving storage stuff — basically closet to closet. Non-essential things... scrap yard tables, tools; the Inspiration Station.
 - Medium to Heavy Labor.
- **Monday, January 26:**
 - Move product.
 - Lite to Medium Labor.
- **Tuesday, January 27:**
 - Move product.
 - Lite to Medium Labor.
- **Wednesday, January 28:**
 - Am: Move product.
 - Lite to Medium Labor.
 - Afternoon: Begin moving fixtures and other furniture.
 - Medium to Heavy labor.
- **Thursday, January 29:**
 - Move large fixtures, paper racks and other furniture items.
 - HEAVY Labor. **NEED lots of help this day!**
- **Friday, January 30:**
 - Reset new store.
 - Lite Labor. Requires a good eye and lots of patience.
- **Saturday, January 31:**
 - Reset new store.
 - Lite Labor. Requires a good eye and lots of patience.
- **Sunday, February 1:**
 - Reset new store final placements...
 - Katrina and SH team members.
- **Monday, February 2:**
 - Re-open in NEW space!
