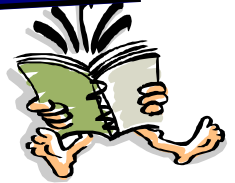

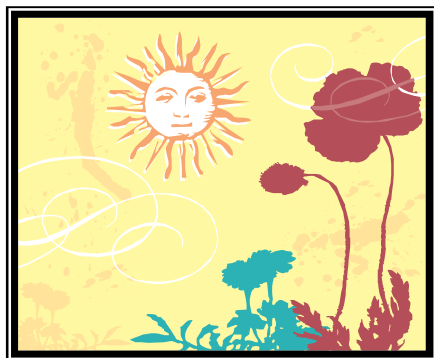

For many classes you may need other specific tools for that class (which we will tell you about.) Payment is required to reserve your placement on the class list; fee listed for class includes all supplies, unless indicated otherwise. Call 507-452-1740 to reserve a spot. Cancellation must be made within 48 hours to receive a refund. **To avoid class cancellations register early; we reserve the right to cancel any class or crop with less than 4 registered participants.**

### Best tool for the job!

Let's talk Tweezers!

My fingers are big and clumsy, and now that I have my nails back on, they are even more useless, at least as it relates to small brads, eyelets, buttons and the like! Cutouts (like Cricut letters) are impossible to deal with without a tweezers.

The scrapping tweezers we carry and recommend are “reverse action” tweezers, which simply means you do the work (squeeze) to open them, then when you let go, they are closed tight! These are wonderful for working on a project... no more hand fatigue, they make small objects friendly again!
